R E S O L U T I O N

BE IT RESOLVED by the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California that gas and electric utilities operating in California under the jurisdiction of the Commission may destroy records at the expiration of the retention periods prescribed in the Federal Power Commission's Regulations to Govern the Preservation of Records of Natural Gas Companies and in the Regulations to Govern the Preservation of Records of Public Utilities and Licensees, which documents are effective December 12, 1962.
