851.5 PIPELINE PATROLLING

Form 62-4648 "Daily Patrol and Work Report" is used to record patrolling operations for followup and permanent record. A few locations use "Station Log Book" where this form meets a specific need and satisfies the requirements. The Pipe Line Operations Department Aerial Patrol Report form is used for this type of patrol which covers conservatively over one-half of all of our pipelines.

Attached also are pertinent Standard Practices and Standards in conjunction with the surveillance and followup.
