## PACIFIC GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY GAS EMERGENCY PLAN

The Pacific Gas & Electric Company Emergency Plan is divided into six parts, as described below:

<u>Part I, Basic Plan</u>, outlines the responsibilities and procedures that PG&E must have in place to respond to gas emergencies, as required by the California Public Utilities Commission General Order 112-E.

<u>Part II, Gas Emergency Skill Assessment and Development Guide,</u> is a tool to assess and develop emergency response skills of employees. There are individual packages for the various Departments and Business Units.

<u>Part III, Gas Emergency Quick Reference</u>, is an extract of Part I and is intended to provide the emergency supervisor/on-call advisor a quick reference to various documents and procedures, such as phone lists and local procedures.

<u>Part IV</u>, <u>Gas Emergency Checklist</u>, contains checklists of specific actions to consider when responding to typical gas emergencies.

\*\* Part V, Annual Procedural Training Aid, contains a PowerPoint based module template, a performance checkpackage, and a job aid for the training coordinator.

\* Part VI, Appendices, are procedures and documents that are specific to the local operating department's gas emergency plan.

Parts III, IV, and VI should be in the emergency supervisor/on call advisor's possession to enable effective gas emergency response.
