

PACIFIC GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY GAS EMERGENCY PLAN

The Pacific Gas & Electric Company Emergency Plan is divided into six parts, as described below:

Part I, Basic Plan, outlines the responsibilities and procedures that PG&E must have in place to respond to gas emergencies, as required by the California Public Utilities Commission General Order 112-E.

Part II, Gas Emergency Skill Assessment and Development Guide, is a tool to assess and develop emergency response skills of employees. There are individual packages for the various Departments and Business Units.

Part III, Gas Emergency Quick Reference, is an extract of Part I and is intended to provide the emergency supervisor/on-call advisor a quick reference to various documents and procedures, such as phone lists and local procedures.

Part IV, Gas Emergency Checklist, contains checklists of specific actions to consider when responding to typical gas emergencies.

**** Part V, Annual Procedural Training Aid**, contains a PowerPoint based module template, a performance check package, and a job aid for the training coordinator.

*** Part VI, Appendices**, are procedures and documents that are specific to the local operating department's gas emergency plan.

Parts III, IV, and VI should be in the emergency supervisor/on call advisor's possession to enable effective gas emergency response.

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
