## Purpose

The purpose of this bulletin is to specify in one document the record retention requirements of repairs on all gas transmission facilities, other than pipe. Federal code CFR 192.709 states that the date, location, and description of each repair made to parts of the pipeline system, other than pipe, must be retained for at least 5 years or until the next patrol, survey, inspection, or test is completed, whichever is longer. Listed below are types of repairs other than pipe, the governing document, and the required retention timeframe specified in the document.

Information contained in this bulletin will be incorporated into a new work procedure under <u>USSRY</u> <u>Standard TD-40015</u>. Gas Standards Documentation Regultements

The Regulatory Support & Analysis Department (RS&A) within Gas Engineering has overall responsibility to implement the process described herein. Gas Transmission Maintenance and Construction (M&C) and Distribution Directors and Superintendents are responsible for ensuring employees in their departments understand and follow the record retention requirements.
