Dear Ms. Edwards:

AT&T California has been providing its U-verse TV service in Anaheim since 2006 pursuant to the March 7, 2006, agreement between AT&T and the City. As stipulated in that agreement, AT&T does not collect franchise fee payments from its subscribers in Anaheim, nor does it remit any franchise fee payments to the city.

To ensure uniformity in our reporting obligations and other administrative processes, AT&T plans to amend the state-issued video franchise we received in March 2007 so that it will now include Anaheim. In accordance with Anaheim Ordinance 6094 (copy attached), AT&T will not pay a franchise fee to the city. Should the city decide at any time in the future that it wishes to receive franchise fees, please notify your AT&T External Affairs manager and complete the attached survey, so that we know to whom payments must be sent. At that time, AT&T will begin to collect and remit the surcharges on a going-forward basis.

Please see the attached supplemental application filed today with the California Public Utilities Commission (“CPUC”). The CPUC has a maximum of 30 days to determine the completeness of the application.
