Attached is AT&T California's application for the first Amendment to its state-issued Video franchise. The purpose of the amendment is to add Highland, California to AT&T California's video service area.

AT&T California already has a surety bond in the amount of \$500,000, so with the change made regarding bond requirements in D.08-07-007, no additional bond is required. As per General Order 169, VI.C.1, there is no fee required to amend a franchise to change the service territory.
