Re: Audeamus (dba. Sebastian) Notice of Termination of State-Issued Video Franchise

Dear Mr. Morris:

Pursuant to Public Utilities Code Section 5840(m)(5), Audeamus hereby provides notice of its intent to terminate its state-issued video franchise. Audeamus received its franchise, numbered 0023, in August 2011. Audeamus currently has no video customers, so there are no customers to notify of this intent to terminate the video franchise. All customers that previously subscribed to Audeamus's video service were individually notified of Audeamus's intent to exit the video market during 2013, and Audeamus worked with customers to ensure that those who desired continued video service were able to receive it from alternative providers. The Westside Cities Cable Authority and Fresno County, the relevant local authorities governing Audeamus's video footprint, were informed of Audeamus's intent to exit the market in February 2014. All outstanding franchise fees and PEG fees have been paid to the local authorities.

Audeamus understands that this letter is sufficient to consummate the termination of its state-issued video franchise. Audeamus would like that termination to be effective as of the date of this letter.
