The initial application for state issued franchises for these areas of unincorporated Los Angeles and Riverside Counties was submitted in November, 2007, with the franchises issued to become effective January 2, 2008. At the time of submission of the initial application, TWC used the service area descriptions outlined in the original franchise agreements. These original descriptions did not account for annexations by neighboring cities over the years following the effective date of the locally issued franchise. This amended filing is intended to accurately reflect the actual service areas and identify duplicate census tracts. Please note with respect to the response to Question 15 on the zipped excel application, there is an additional column in the Q15.xls for indication of a duplicate census tract.
