### TO THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

California Utilities Service, Inc. (CUS) hereby transmits for filing four copies each of the following tariff schedules, which are attached hereto:

The present rates of California Utilities Service, Inc. (CUS) became effective on April 24, 2017, pursuant to Advice Letter No. 61, which adopted CPI offset of \$35,585 or 2.1% annually, due to the 2016 CPI-U of 02.1%. The last general rate increase became effective on August 18, 2010 pursuant to Resolution No.W-4837, which authorized a general rate increase of \$723,777 or 88.4%, and a return based on a rate of margin of 21.7%.

#### **Summary**

CUS is filing this Advice Letter in compliance with Resolution M-4836, which ordered a change in the Reimbursement Account User Fees, effective April 1, 2019, from 1.40% to 1.23%.

### **Background**

CUS is filing this Advice Letter in compliance with Resolution M-4839 ordering a change in the current Public Utilities Commission Utilities Reimbursement Account (PUCURA) user fees for all utilities regulated by the California Public Utilities Commission.

This filing is made under the provisions of General Order No. 96-B, Water Industry Rule 7.3.1(3).

This filing will not cause withdrawal of service nor conflict with any other schedule or rule.

### **Requested Effective Date:**

This filing is a Tier 1 advice letter per General Order 96-B, Water Industry Rule 7.3.1.(3). CUS respectfully requests an effective date of April 1, 2019 for Advice Letter No. 69.

### **Notice:**

In compliance with Section 4.3 of General Order No. 96-B, a copy of this advice letter has been mailed to all parties listed on the enclosed service list.

### **Protests and Responses:**

Anyone may respond to or protest this advice letter. A response supports the filing and may contain information that proves useful to the Commission in evaluating the advice letter. A protest objects to the advice letter in whole or in part and must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds are:

- (1) The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the advice letter;
- (2) The relief requested in the advice letter would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;
- (3) The analysis, calculations, or data in the advice letter contain material error or omissions;
- (4) The relief requested in the advice letter is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding; or
- (5) The relief requested in the advice letter requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the advice letter process; or
- (6) The relief requested in the advice letter is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory (provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require relitigating a prior order of the Commission.)

A protest shall provide citations or proofs where available to allow staff to properly consider the protest.

A response or protest must be made in writing or by electronic mail and must be received by the Water Division within 20 days of the date this advice letter is filed. The address for mailing or delivering a protest is:

Cities and counties that need Board of Supervisors or Board of Commissioners approval to protest should inform the Water Division, within the 20 day protest period, so that a late filed protest can be entertained. The informing document should include an estimate of the date the proposed protest might be voted on.

Replies: The utility shall reply to each protest and may reply to any response. Each reply must be received by the Division of Water and Audits within five business days after the end of the protest period, and shall be served on the same day to the person who filed the protest or response.
