<u>REQUEST</u>

With this supplemental filing Bass Lake hereby requests authority to update Commission Staff on replacement reservoir construction status, project cost, and final Plumas Bank loan amount. The request to increase the Bass Lake loan amount from \$620,000 was approved by Plumas Bank loan committee on May 28, 2020 to \$780,000. The current project cost estimate has been increased by \$200,000 to \$975,000 from the prior estimate of \$775,000. This results in the RBO amount increasing to the new project estimated cost of \$975,000. The construction completion date should be July 30, 2020. The final cost will not be under \$975,000 so Bass Lake requests that the above numbers be used by the Commission staff in obtaining Commissioner Resolution approval so the rate adjustment can be implemented as quickly as possible and allow Plumas Bank to finalize the loan documents.

Currently Bass Lake has executed a Construction Loan Promissory Note with Plumas Bank that will be updated as reflected above. After construction is complete and the Commission has approved the loan and RBO in the respective amounts of \$780,000 loan and \$975,000 the Bass Lake loan will be finalized with Plumas Bank and the payment of the loan origination fee. Anything over the \$975,000 will be funded by Bass Lake.

Residual funding of approximately \$195,000 will be made with company funds. See attached revised capital structure and cash flow projections supporting the availability of this funding. Insurance proceeds in the amount of \$56,855 has been received and been used for demolition, grading, and other work in preparation of tank erecting.

Bass Lake as a part of this supplemental filing request that all customer Rates be increased by 34.34% or \$311,039 revenue requirement to provide a rate of return of 12.15% as was approved by Resolution 4741-W. See attached revised summary of earnings. This increase is necessary to satisfy the Plumas Bank loan requirements and a rate of return to cover current operating costs and the loan repayment. The attached tariff sheets reflect this increase in rates.

- 5. The relief requested in the AL requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the AL process; or
- 6. The relief requested in the AL is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory, provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require relitigating a prior order of the Commission.

NOTICE TO CUSTOMERS OF PROPOSED RATE INCREASE

June 11, 2020 Draft

The Bass Lake Water Company has requested authority from the California Public Utilities Commission to increase rates by \$311,039 or 34.34%, for a rate base offset for the cost of replacing the Pines storage facility with a new above ground bolted steel tank. Bass Lake is also requesting approval of a \$780,000 Plumas Bank Loan for the \$975,000 estimated project cost. Insurance proceeds and company funds will cover the remainder of the overall project cost. The Water Board has wanted the old tank replaced with a newer style of tank. This filing has been prepared in accordance with Standard Practice U-27. The resulting rates will not result in a rate of return in excess of what has been found reasonable for the Bass Lake Water Company.
