REQUEST

By Advice Letter (AL) No. 73-W, Big Basin seeks to report to the Commission that it has completed the surcredit and had fully reimbursed the ratepayers portion in the Timber Operations Balancing Account (TOBA) for the years 2015 and 2017, as required in Ordering Paragraph No. 5 of Resolution W-5051. Both TOBA accounts have zero balances. Therefore, Big Basin requests authority to cease the surcredit for both accounts.

Big Basin also requests to establish a surcredit of \$7.38 a month for metered customers and flat rate customers for 12 months to amortize the balances recorded in Timber Operations Balancing Account (TOBA) in 2018. Big Basin received \$177,304.05 for the timber harvest operations in 2018. The ratepayers' portion of the timber revenue is \$53,191.22 (30% of the timber revenue received).

The Commission staff has been provided with documents supporting the balancing accounts accruals.

This Advice Letter will not provide additional net revenue for Big Basin. It will not result in any increase in its authorized rate of return.

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Big Basin respectfully requests expedited handling of this advice letter.

BACKGROUND

Per Ordering Paragraph No. 3, Resolution W-4526, Big Basin is required to record 30% of the proceeds to the TOBA as the share of the ratepayers for its timber harvesting operations. Big Basin had operations in 2015 that generated revenue of \$82,921.29 of which \$24,876.39 was recorded in its TOBA for 2015 and revenue of \$127,364 of which \$38,209.37 was recorded in its TOBA for 2017. A surcredit of \$2.34 monthly was paid to metered and flat rate ratepayers until the balances on both TOBA accounts had been fully paid. Big Basin acknowledges that it had made a mistake in not closing the 2015 surcredit in its tariff once it was fully paid and then arbitrarily applying the same surcredit amount of \$2.34 to amortize the 2017 TOBA balance. Big Basin should have requested authority from the Commission to institute a new surcredit amount for the 2017 TOBA balance. Big Basin begs the Commission's indulgence for this failure. To mitigate its error and make sure that the ratepayers are correctly and fully reimbursed with their share of the timber harvesting revenues for 2015 and 2017, Big Basin had engaged a third party CPA firm, splettStoesser, to review the 2015 and 2017 TOBA account balances and reimbursement amounts separately. The CPA report shows that the 2015 revenue was \$82,921.29 and \$24,9537.39 was fully reimbursed on July 14, 2017 and that the 2017 revenue was \$127,364.58 and \$38,923.83 were fully reimbursed on November 15, 2019. The CPA report is attached.

In 2018, Big Creek Lumber harvested timber and paid Big Basin \$177,304.05 for the timber as agreed according to the terms cited in Big Basin and Big Creek Lumber Timber Sale Contract that was approved in Resolution W-5051. The amount recorded in TOBA is \$53,191.22 in 2018. Big Basin's proposes a surcredit of \$7.38 a month for metered customers and flat rate customers for 12 months to amortize the TOBA balance.

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TIER DESIGNATION AND REQUESTED EFFECTIVE DATE

These tariffs are submitted pursuant to Water Industry Rule 7.3.1(1) of General Order (GO.) 96-B and this advice letter is designated as a Tier 2 filing. This advice letter will become effective upon approval or deemed approval by DWA staff.

NOTICE

In compliance with GO. 96-B, General Rule 4.3 and 4.7, a copy of this advice letter has been served to all parties on service list AL #73-W.

This filing will not cause withdrawal of service nor conflict with any other schedule or rule.

RESPONSE OR PROTEST

Anyone may respond to or protest this advice letter. A response supports the filing and may contain information that proves useful to the Commission in evaluating the advice letter. A protest objects to the advice letter in whole or in part and must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds are:

- 1. The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the advice letter;
- 2. The relief requested in the advice letter would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;
- The analysis, calculations, or data in the advice letter contain material error or omissions;
- 4. The relief requested in the advice letter is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding; or
- 5. The relief requested in the advice letter requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the advice letter process; or
- 6. The relief requested in the advice letter is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory (provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require relitigating a Prior order of the Commission).

A protest shall provide citations or proofs where available to allow staff to properly consider the protest. A response or protest must be made in writing or by electronic mail and must be received by DWA within 20 days of the date this advice letter is filed. The informing document should include an estimate of the date the proposed protest might be voted on.

REPLIES

The utility shall reply to each protest and may reply to any response. Each reply must be received by DWA within five business days after the end of the protest period, and shall be served on the same day to the person who filed the protest or response.
