REQUEST/PURPOSE

By Advice Letter No. 127, Hillview Water Company, Inc. requests permission to revoke its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity and to cancel tariffs per Ordering Paragraph 3 of Decision 19-11-003 dated November 7, 2019.

BACKGROUND

Decision 19-11-003 authorized the sale of stock of Hillview Water Company, Inc. to California American Water Company effective November 7, 2019. Ordering Paragraph 3 of Decision 19-11-003 also orders "California-American Water Company's CPCN is expanded to include the service territory of Hillview Water Company, Inc."

TIER DESIGNATION AND REQUESTED EFFECTIVE DATE

This AL is submitted pursuant to General Order (GO.) 96-B 7.3.1 (3). AL 127 is designated as a Tier 1 AL filing with a requested effective on filing.

NOTICE

In compliance with Section 4.3 of General Order No. 96-8, a copy of this advice letter has been served to all parties listed on the enclosed service list. Customer notice is not required for a Tier 1 advice letter filing.

RESPONSE OR PROTEST

Anyone may respond to or protest this AL. A response supports the filing and may contain information that proves useful to the Commission in evaluating the AL. A protest objects to the AL in whole or in part and must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds are:

1. The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the AL;
2. The relief requested in the AL would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;
3. The analysis, calculations, or data in the AL contain material error or omission;
4. The relief requested in the AL is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding; or
5. The relief requested in the AL requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the AL process; or
6. The relief requested in the AL is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory, provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require re litigating a prior order of the Commission.

RESPONSE OR PROTEST (CONTINUED)

A protest may not rely on policy objections to an AL where the relief requested in the AL follows rules or directions established by statute or Commission order applicable to the utility.

A protest shall provide citations or proofs where available to allow staff to properly consider the protest. DWA must receive a response or protest via email (or postal mail) within 20 days of the date this AL is filed. The addresses for submitting a response or protest are:

Cities and counties that need Board of Supervisors or Board of Commissioners approval to protest should inform DWA, within the 20 day protest period, so that a late filed protest can be entertained. The informing document should include an estimate of the date the proposed protest might be voted on.


REPLIES

The utility shall reply to each protest and may reply to any response. Any reply must be received by DWA within five business days after the end of the protest period, and shall be served on the same day on each person who filed the protest or response to the AL.

This filing is made under the provisions of General Order No. 96-8.


