3. **Per Res. W-XXXX, a \$13.30 bill surcharge shall be applied to each customer's monthly water bill to amortize the Unexpected Repair Cost Balancing Account of \$10,212.75. The surcharge shall be separately identified on each bill and in place for a period of 24 months, or until the full amount has been collected, from the effective date of Res. W-XXXX.** (N)
