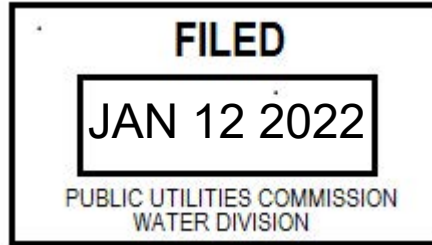

**Subject:** Region 3 Advice Letter Projects – Ratebase Offset

**PURPOSE**

These tariffs are submitted pursuant to Decision No. (D.) 19-05-044, dated May 30, 2019, in Application No. 17-07-010, filed July 19, 2017. GSWC is seeking authorization for rate recovery of the costs of completed, operational, used and useful capital projects in its Region 3 service area.

**BACKGROUND**

Ordering Paragraph Nos. 9 and 10 in D. 19-05-044 in GSWC’s Application No. 17-07-010 states,

9. *Golden State Water Company is authorized to file an offset advice letter to seek recovery for the following project: Golden Reservoir Replacement Project in the Region 3 Ratemaking Area.*
10. *Golden State Water Company is authorized to file an offset advice letter to seek recovery for the following project: College, Construct Replacement Reservoir in the Region 3 Ratemaking Area.*

Accordingly, GSWC is filing this advice letter to include in rate base and to recover the corresponding revenue requirement for the completed reservoir projects in the Region 3 service area. The aforementioned projects were two of the seven advice letter projects referenced in Table 3.14 of the Settlement Agreement adopted in D.19-05-044.

**DISCUSSION**

The authorized budget for the capital projects and their respective actual costs are summarized in the tables below.

The Commission authorized two 2017 GRC advice letter projects totaling \$11.8 million for the construction of three storage tanks and the replacement of a booster station. GSWC was able to construct three storage tanks and a booster station for \$9.4 million, saving approximately \$2.4 million in capital expenditures, and reducing pumping costs by eliminating the originally proposed 1.2 MG of 'submerged' storage at the Golden Plant.

**REVENUE REQUIREMENT**

The combined revenue requirement for the two authorized Region 3 capital projects is \$1,179,714.

**WORKPAPERS**

The supporting workpapers showing the calculation of the revenue requirement and rate design are being supplied to the Commission's Water Division and Public Advocates Office.

**BILL IMPACT**

A residential customer on Schedule No. R3-1-R with a 5/8" x 3/4" meter using 11 Ccfs will receive a monthly increase of \$0.54 or 0.87%.

A non-residential customer on Schedule No. R3-1-NR with a 5/8" x 3/4" meter using 67 Ccfs will receive a monthly increase of \$2.65 or 0.88%.

**TIER DESIGNATION**

This advice letter is submitted with a Tier 2 designation.

**EFFECTIVE DATE**

GSWC is requesting the tariffs contained herein have an effective date of February 15, 2022.

**CUSTOMER NOTICE**

This is a Tier 2 advice letter that requires customer notification, as provided in Water Industry Rule 7.3.1 of General Order 96-B. GSWC will notify its customers of this rate increase by placing a message on the customer water bills that are generated after the rate increase goes into effect. GSWC has attached a copy of its Customer Notice Verification with the drafted bill message language.

**RESPONSE OR PROTEST**

Anyone may submit a response or protest for this Advice Letter (AL). When submitting a response or protest, **please include the utility name and advice letter number in the subject line.**

A **response** supports the filing and may contain information that proves useful to the Commission in evaluating the AL. A **protest** objects to the AL in whole or in part and must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds are:

1. The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the AL;
2. The relief requested in the AL would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;
3. The analysis, calculations, or data in the AL contain material error or omissions;
4. The relief requested in the AL is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding; or
5. The relief requested in the AL requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the AL process; or
6. The relief requested in the AL is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory, provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require re-litigating a prior order of the Commission.

A protest may not rely on policy objections to an AL where the relief requested in the AL follows rules or directions established by statute or Commission order applicable to the utility. A protest shall provide citations or proofs where available to allow staff to properly consider the protest.

The Water Division (WD) must receive a response or protest via email (or postal mail) within 20 days of the date the AL is filed. When submitting a response or protest, **please include the utility name and advice letter number in the subject line.**

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Cities and counties that need Board of Supervisors or Board of Commissioners approval to protest should inform WD, within the 20-day protest period, so that a late filed protest can be entertained. The informing document should include an estimate of the date the proposed protest might be voted on.

### **REPLIES**

The utility shall reply to each protest and may reply to any response. Any reply must be received by WD within five business days after the end of the protest period, and shall be served on the same day on each person who filed the protest or response to the AL.

The actions requested in this advice letter are not now the subject of any formal filings with the California Public Utilities Commission, including a formal complaint, nor action in any court of law.

Water Service Fee. The Agreement attached to Advice Letter No. 1217-W contains as Exhibit A, a schedule of Fixed Costs supporting the rates specified in GSW's Tariff Schedule R3-1 as of January 1, 2006. If the Effective Date occurs while Fixed Costs remain the same, Forest Lawn will pay an initial monthly Water Service Fee of two thousand, four, hundred forty-six dollars (\$2,446) for GSW's maintaining a potable water connection for use by the Cemetery for irrigation purposes, which the Parties agree is an accurate determination of Forest Lawn's proportional share of said Fixed Costs.

Periodic Adjustments. The amount of the Water Service Fee shall be adjusted, as necessary, concurrently with the effective date of each future change in GSW's CPUC-approved tariff Schedule No. R3-1 or successor tariff to reflect the Cemetery's then proportional share of Fixed Costs. The methodology for said adjustments shall be the same as that set forth in Exhibit A to the Agreement attached to Advice Letter No. 1217-W.
