Suburban Water Systems ("Suburban") hereby submits for filing with the Commission the following changes in its tariff sheets which are attached hereto:

By this advice letter, Suburban requests an authorization to implement Ordering Paragraph (OP) 9 Decision (D.) 22-04-010, Decision authorizing the purchase of Sativa Los Angeles County Water District by Suburban Water Systems.

OP 9 of D.22-04-010 states:

9. Suburban Water Systems is authorized to file a Tier 1 Advice Letter to establish a Compliance Issues for Acquisitions Memorandum Account consistent with this Decision.

D.22-04-010 granted Suburban requests for an authorization to file advice letters for recovery on an annual basis beginning on March 1, 2024, for costs tracked in 2021. Subsequent advice letters will be filed on March 1, 2025, and March 1, 2026, for costs tracked in the years 2022 and 2023, respectively. Consequently, to clarify the memorandum account, Suburban has included the timing on the recovery of the costs to this specific memorandum account.

Further advice letters should not be necessary as the acquisition should be fully incorporated into Suburban's revenue requirement beginning with the Test Year 2024.

Tier Designation and Effective Date

Pursuant to OP 9 of D.22-04-010 this advice letter is submitted with a Tier 1 designation. Suburban requests that the advice letter is effective on December 22, 2022, the date of this advice letter is being filed with the Commission.

Protest and Responses

Anyone may respond to or protest this advice letter. A response supports the filing and may contain information that proves useful to the Commission in evaluating the advice letter.

A protest objects to the advice letter in whole or in part and must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds are:

(1) The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the advice letter;

- (2) The relief requested in the advice letter would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;
- (3) The analysis, calculations, or data in the advice letter contain material error or omissions;
- (4) The relief requested in the advice letter is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding; or
- (5) The relief requested in the advice letter requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the advice letter process; or
- (6) The relief requested in the advice letter is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory (provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require relitigating a prior order of the Commission.)

A protest shall provide citations or proofs where available to allow staff to properly consider the protest.

A response or protest must be made in writing or by electronic mail and must be received by the Water Division within 20 days of the date this advice letter is filed. The address for mailing or delivering a protest is:

Cities and counties that need Board of Supervisors or Board of Commissioners approval to protest should inform the Water Division, within the 20 days protest period, so that a late filed protest can be entertained. The informing document should include an estimate of the date the proposed protest might be voted on.

Replies: The utility shall reply to each protest and may reply to any response. Each reply must be received by the Division of Water and Audits within 5 business days after the end of the protest period and shall be served on the same day to the person who filed the protest or response.

This filing will not cause the withdrawal of service, nor conflict with other schedules or rules.

In compliance with General Rule 4.3 and 7.2 and Water Industry Rule 4.1 of General Order 96-B, a copy of this advice letter has been mailed or electronically transmitted to all interested and affected parties as detailed in Attachment A.
