SUBJECT: Establishment of Memorandum Account to Track and Record

Above-Ground Decommissioned Pipe Soil Remediation and

Below-Ground Decommissioned Pipe Pre-Construction

Activities Costs for the Catalina Water Utility

In compliance Ordering Paragraph (OP) 1 of Decision (D.)22-09-008 (D.22-09-008 or Decision) dated September 15, 2022, Southern California Edison Company (SCE) hereby submits to the California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) the following changes to its tariffs for water service on Santa Catalina Island. The revised tariff sheets are listed on Attachment A and are attached hereto.

PURPOSE

This advice letter establishes Preliminary Statement Part U, Catalina Water Decommissioned Pipe Memorandum Account (CWDPMA), of SCE's Water Tariffs pursuant to OP 2 of D.22-09-008.

BACKGROUND

SCE's Catalina Water operations is a Class C utility serving approximately 2,000 customer accounts across Santa Catalina Island. SCE acquired the Catalina water utility in 1962 and is the sole water purveyor on the island, providing potable water service to approximately 4,100 residents and one-million annual visitors to the island.

On June 4, 2021, SCE filed Application (A.)21-06-007 seeking authorization to establish a memorandum account to record and track costs for certain decommissioned pipe preconstruction and soil remediation activities for the Catalina water utility.

On September 15, 2022, the Commission approved D.22-09-008, authorizing SCE to establish a memorandum account to track the costs to perform soil remediation associated with previously removed above-ground decommissioned pipe and preconstruction activities associated with below-ground decommissioned pipe. The Decision authorized an effective date of June 4, 2021 for the memorandum account,3 the same date SCE filed its application. Finally, the Decision authorized SCE to submit a Tier 1 advice letter to establish the CWDPMA.4

PROPOSED TARIFF CHANGES

In accordance with the Decision, SCE is establishing the following tariff:

• Preliminary Statement U – Catalina Water Decommissioned Pipe Memorandum Account.

TIER DESIGNATION

Pursuant to General Order 96-B, Water Industry Rule 7.3.1(3) and OP 1 of D.22-09-008, this advice letter is submitted with a Tier 1 designation.

EFFECTIVE DATE

Pursuant to OP 2 of D.22-09-008, this advice letter and attached tariffs have an effective date of June 4, 2021.

U. Catalina Water Decommissioned Pipe Memorandum Account (CWDPMA)

1. Purpose

The purpose of the Catalina Water Decommissioned Pipe Memorandum Account (CWDPMA) is to record costs associated with planning and project development activities necessary for the remediation of below-ground decommissioned pipe facilities characterized during a system-wide assessment of SCE's water distribution infrastructure. Additionally, SCE will record soil remediation costs associated with previously removed above-ground decommissioned pipe as authorized in D.22-09-008.

2. **Applicability**

Costs tracked in the CWDPMA will be recovered from customer classes that the Commission designates in its discretion in connection with the proceeding resolving the reasonableness review of the recorded costs.

3. Operation of the CWDPMA

The following entries will be recorded monthly (if applicable) to the CWDPMA:

A debit entry equal to the recorded costs associated with performing planning and project development activities relating to below-ground decommissioned pipe and/or soil remediation activities relating to above-ground decommissioned pipe on Catalina.

4. Interest

Interest expense shall accrue monthly in the CWDPMA by applying one-twelfth of the most recent Federal Reserve three-month Commercial Paper Rate - nonfinancial, from the Federal Reserve's Statistical Release H.15 (expressed as an annual rate) to the average monthly balance in the CWDPMA. If a nonfinancial rate is not published by the Federal Reserve in a given month, SCE shall use the Federal Reserve's three-month Commercial Paper Rate - financial.

5. Disposition

The costs recorded in the CWDPMA may be recovered in rates only after a request by SCE, a showing of reasonableness, and approval by the Commission. The costs recorded in the CWDPMA shall be presented to the Commission for review of reasonableness and recovery in a future application, consistent with D.22-09-008.
