REQUEST

By AL 22-W, Lytle Springs Water Company requests permission to increase its revenues (based on increase to the present monthly quantity rate and service charge) by 7.0%, the Consumer Price Index (CPI) for 2021. The projected revenue increase of \$1,048 will not result in a rate of return which exceeds the authorized rate of return of 7%. Workpapers justifying this increase are enclosed.

BACKGROUND

The present rates became effective on February 15, 2022, pursuant to Resolution W-4493, which authorized an offset (CPI) rate increase of \$1,048, or 7%.

The last general rate increase became effective on June 1, 1973, pursuant to Resolution W-1447, which authorized a general rate increase of \$0, or 0%, and a rate of return of 0%.

AL 22-W is filed pursuant to Ordering Paragraphs No. 1 of Decision 92-03-093 and Resolution W- 4493, which authorized Class C and D water and sewer utilities to file a request for a CPI increase once a year by AL. The increase is to be passed on to the utility's customers in their quantity rate and service charge.
