The present rates of Alco became effective on July 27, 2014, pursuant to Commission Decision 11-03-005 ("D.1103005") and Advice Letter No. 157 ("AL 157"), through which the Commission authorized Alco a rate base offset of \$68,372 or 0.83% as approved by D.1103005.

Summary

Alco is filing this Advice Letter in compliance with Resolution M-4874, which ordered a change in the Reimbursement Account User Fees, effective January 1, 2025, from 0.70% to 0.68%.

Background

Alco is filing this Advice Letter in compliance with Resolution M-4874 ordering a change in the current Public Utilities Commission Utilities Reimbursement Account (PUCURA) user fees for all utilities regulated by the California Public Utilities Commission.

This filing is made under the provisions of General Order No. 96-B.

This filing will not cause withdrawal of service nor conflict with any other schedule or rule.

Requested Effective Date

This filing is a Tier 1 advice letter per General Order 96-B, Water Industry Rule 7.3.1.(3). Alco respectfully requests an effective date of January 1, 2025 for Advice Letter No. 218.

Notice

Protests and Responses:

Anyone may respond to or protest this advice letter. A response supports the filing and may contain information that proves useful to the Commission in evaluating the advice letter. A protest objects to the advice letter in whole or in part and must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds are:

- (1) The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the advice letter;
- (2) The relief requested in the advice letter would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;
- (3) The analysis, calculations, or data in the advice letter contain material error or omissions;
- (4) The relief requested in the advice letter is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding; or
- (5) The relief requested in the advice letter requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the advice letter process; or
- (6) The relief requested in the advice letter is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory (provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require relitigating a prior order of the Commission.)

A protest shall provide citations or proofs where available to allow staff to properly consider the protest.
