2. In accordance with Section 2714 of the Public Utilities Code, if a tenant in a rental unit leaves owing the company, service to subsequent tenants in that unit will, at the company's option, be furnished on the account of the landlord or property owner.
3. All bills are subject to the Reimbursement Fee set forth in Schedule No. UF.
4. ~~A \$5.80 bill surcharge shall be applied to each customer's monthly water bill to amortize the Purchased Water Balancing Account of \$69,143.07. The surcharge shall be separately identified on each bill and in place for a period of 12 months, or until the full amount has been collected from the effective date of Advice Letter 87 W.~~ (D)

4. A \$20.89 bill surcharge shall be applied to each customer's monthly water bill to amortize the Purchased Water Balancing Account of \$246,617. The surcharge shall be separately identified on each bill and in place for a period of 12 months, or until the full amount has been collected from the effective date of Advice Letter 94-W.

4. ~~A onetime surcharge of \$60,125.94 shall be imposed to all customers to offset the authorized but not collected revenue from January 1, 2016, the effective dates of the interim rates authorized by Resolutions W-4540 and W-4658, through August 3, 2016, the date rates authorized by Resolution W-5094 were effective. The surcharge shall be collected over a period of 24 monthly billing periods and it is based on service charge rates and quantity rate. The quantity rate surcharge shall be charged per Ccf of water sold.~~ (D)
