ADVICE 145-W (U 338-W)

PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA WATER DIVISION

SUBJECT: Update to the Public Utilities Commission Reimbursement Fee

Southern California Edison Company (SCE) hereby submits to the California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) the following changes to its tariffs for water service on Santa Catalina Island. The revised tariff sheets are listed on Attachment A and are attached hereto.

PURPOSE

In compliance with Resolution M-4874, this advice letter revises Schedule UF-W, *Surcharge to Fund Public Utilities Reimbursement Fee*, to reflect the updated fee effective January 1, 2025.

BACKGROUND

The Public Utilities Reimbursement Fee (PUCRF) was established by the California legislature in 1983 to fund the regulation of public utilities by the Commission. The Commission determines the level of fees necessary to fund its annual budget and to maintain a reserve.

Section 431 of the Public Utilities Code provides:

"The commission shall annually determine a fee to be paid by every electrical, gas, telephone, telegraph, water, sewer system, and heat corporation and every other public utility providing service directly to customers and subscribers and subject to the jurisdiction of the commission other than a railroad, except as provided in Article 2 (commencing with Section 421). The annual fee shall be established to produce a total amount equal to that amount established in the authorized commission budget for the same year, including adjustments for increases in employee compensation, other increases appropriated by the Legislature, and an appropriate reserve to regulate public utilities..."

After determining the total budget requirement to be recovered through the PUCRF, the Commission allocates fees to the classes of public utilities based on the resources required to regulate each class.

Section 432 of the Public Utilities Code provides:

"The fee allocation among classes of public utilities shall reflect expenditures by the commission on regulatory and other authorized activities affecting each respective class, and shall bear the same ratio that the commission's workload for each class of public utility subject to the fee bears to the commission's total workload for all public utilities subject to the fee."

PROPOSED TARIFF CHANGES

On December 19, 2024, the Commission adopted Resolution M-4874 (the Resolution), which sets forth the levels of PUCRF effective January 1, 2024. As a result, the currently effective PUCRF surcharge of 0.70 percent is decreased to 0.68 percent of revenue and is reflected within Schedule UF-W.

No cost information is required for this advice letter.

TIER DESIGNATION

Pursuant to General Order (GO) 96-B, Water Industry Rule 7.3.1(3), this advice letter is submitted with a Tier 1 designation.

EFFECTIVE DATE

Pursuant to the Resolution, the changes submitted in this advice letter will become effective on January 1, 2025.

Schedule No. UF-W SURCHARGE TO FUND PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION REIMBURSEMENT FEE

APPLICABILITY

This surcharge applies to all water bills rendered under all tariff rate schedules authorized by the Commission, with the exception of resale rate schedules where the customer is a public utility.

TERRITORY

This schedule is applicable within the entire	territory served by the Company.
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A 0.68% surcharge shall be added to all customer bills.

RATES*

*	In 1983 the Legislature established the Public Utilities Commission Reimbursement Fee to be paid by Utilities to fund their regulation by the Commission (Public Utilities (PU) Code Section 401-443). The surcharge to recover the cost

of that fee is ordered by the Commission under authority granted by PU Code Section 433.
