TO THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

#### **REOUEST**

Foothill Ditch Company (FDC) hereby requests authority pursuant to Sections 816 through 851 and other relevant sections of the Public Utilities Code to authorize an unauthorized debt of \$750,000 on June 30, 2023, from Rock Hill Incorporated (RHI).

#### **BACKGROUND**

FDC converted \$750,000 of payables to affiliated company (RHI) into a long-term promissory note. The term is 10 years, maturing on June 30, 2033, at a fixed rate of 6.5%. As of December 31, 2023, there was an outstanding loan balance of \$722,914. The payables were accrued rental fees from use of motor vehicles, tractors, farm implements, and tools, together with office space and equipment and fees from operational labor and management services provided by RHI.

FDC was unaware of the omission until it was discovered by the Utility Audit Branch (UAB) in its review of FDC's 2023 Annual Report on September 24, 2024. FDC wishes to comply with UAB's recommendations and is seeking authority for the existing long-term debt.

FDC's system is solely for irrigation purposes. There are no nearby utilities that provide irrigation water. FDC provides water service to 18 metered irrigation customers. Its service area is adjacent to State Highway 108 approximately 21 miles east of Sonora, Tuolumne County.

This filing will not increase the rates and will not cause the withdrawal of service nor conflict other schedules or rules.

The present rates became effective on May 16, 2023, by approval of AL No. 11-W, which implemented a Consumer Price Index increase of \$5,399 or 6.5%.

The last general rate increase became effective on December 7, 1994, pursuant to Resolution W-3894, which authorized a general rate increase of \$6,250, or 8.9% and a rate of return of 13.85%.

#### TIER DESIGNATION AND REQUESTED EFFECTIVE DATE

These AL and enclosed tariffs are submitted pursuant to Water Industry Rule 7.3.3(5) of General Order (GO.) 96-B and this AL is designated as a Tier 3 filing. This AL will become effective upon approval through a Commission Resolution. <sup>1</sup>

may contain information that proves useful to the Commission in evaluating the AL. A protest objects to the AL in whole or in part and must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds are:

- 1. The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the AL;
- 2. The relief requested in the AL would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;
- 3. The analysis, calculations, or data in the AL contain material error or omissions;
- 4. The relief requested in the AL is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding; or
- 5. The relief requested in the AL requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the AL process; or
- 6. The relief requested in the AL is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory, provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require relitigating a prior order of the Commission.

The informing document should include an estimate of the date the proposed protest might be voted on.
