RESIDENTIAL FLAT RATE SERVICE

APPLICABILITY

Applicable to all flat rate residential water service.

TERRITORY

Lazy A Estates and vicinity, adjacent to Highway 395, located approximately one and one-half miles north of Bishop, Inyo County.

RATES

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

- (1) The residential rates apply to a service connection not larger than one inch in diameter.
- (2) For service covered by the above classification, if the utility so elects, a meter shall be installed, and service provided under Schedule No. 1, General Metered Service, effective as of the first day of the following calendar month. Where the flat rate charge for a period has been paid in advance, refund of the prorated difference between such flat rate payment and the minimum meter charge for the same period shall be made on or before that day.
- (3) All bills are subject to the reimbursement fee set forth in Schedule No. UF.

Schedule No. 4
PRIVATE FIRE PROTECTION SERVICE

APPLICABILITY

Applicable to all water service furnished to privately owned fire protection systems.

TERRITORY

This schedule is applicable within the entire territory served by the utility.

RATES

For each inch of diameter of service connection \$ 3.11 (l)

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

- (1) The fire protection service connection shall be installed by the utility and the cost paid by the applicant. Such payment shall not be subject to refund.
- (2) The minimum diameter for fire protection services shall be three inches, and the maximum diameter shall not be more than the diameter of the main to which service is connected.
- (3) If a distribution main of adequate size to serve a private fire protection system in addition to all other normal service does not exist in the street or alley adjacent to the premises to be served, then a service main from the nearest existing main of adequate capacity shall be installed by the utility and the cost paid by the applicant. Such payment shall not be subject to refund.
- (4) Service hereunder is for private fire protection systems to which no connections for other than fire protection purposes are allowed and which are regularly inspected by the underwriters having jurisdiction, are installed according to specifications of the utility, and are maintained to the satisfaction of the utility. The utility may install the standard detector type meter approved by the Board of Fire Underwriters for protection against theft, leakage or waste of water and the cost paid by the applicant. Such payment shall not be subject to refund.
- (5) The utility undertakes to supply only such water at such pressure as may be available at any time through the normal operation of the system.
