Advice Letter No. 45

TO THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

PureSource Water, Inc. (PureSource) hereby transmits for filing one original and one copy of this advice letter (AL) and the following tariff sheets which are enclosed:

REQUEST

By AL No. 45, PureSource requests permission to increase its revenues (based on increase to the present monthly water service rate) by 3.4%, the Consumer Price Index (CPI) for 2023. The projected revenue increase of \$3,758 will not result in a rate of margin which exceeds the authorized rate of margin (ROM) of 18.51%. See note regarding ROM in Background information below. Workpapers justifying this increase are enclosed.

BACKGROUND

The present rates became effective on 2/28/2023, pursuant to Resolution W-4493, which authorized an offset (CPI) rate increase of \$6,746, or 6.5%.

The last general rate increase became effective on 1/29/17, pursuant to Resolution W-5128, which authorized a general rate increase of \$24,985, or 35.69%, and a rate of margin of 18.51%.

Note: The rate of margin (ROM) of 18.51% that was authorized by the last General Rate Case, erroneously did not include the depreciation or taxes in the Summary of Earnings worksheet ROM calculation. When using the proper calculation, including depreciation and taxes, the authorized ROM would have been only 8.53%. AL 45 does not result in a rate of margin exceeding the 18.51% authorized.

AL 45 is filed pursuant to Ordering Paragraphs No.1 of Decision 92-03-093 and Resolution W-4493, which authorized Class C and D water and sewer utilities to file a request for a CPI increase once a year by AL. The increase is to be passed on to the utility's customers in their monthly water service rate.

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TIER DESIGNATION AND REQUESTED EFFECTIVE DATE

This AL and the enclosed tariff sheets are submitted pursuant to General Order (GO.) 96-B. AL 34 is designated as a Tier 1 AL and the enclosed tariff sheets will become effective upon filing.¹

NOTICE

This AL does not require notice;² however, the utility shall inform its customers, by bill insert in the first bill that includes the increase, of the amount of the increase expressed in dollar and percentage terms.³ A copy of this AL has been served to all parties listed on the service list⁴ on the last page of this AL. This filing will not cause withdrawal of service nor conflict with any other schedule or rule.

RESPONSE OR PROTEST⁵

Anyone may respond to or protest this AL. A response supports the filing and may contain information that proves useful to the Commission in evaluating the AL. A protest objects to the AL in whole or in part and must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds are:

- 1. The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the AL;
- 2. The relief requested in the AL would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;
- 3. The analysis, calculations, or data in the AL contain material error or omissions;
- 4. The relief requested in the AL is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding; or
- 5. The relief requested in the AL requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the AL process; or
- 6. The relief requested in the AL is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory (provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require relitigating a prior order of the Commission.

A protest may not rely on policy objections to an AL where the relief requested in the AL follows rules or directions established by statute or Commission order applicable to the utility.

A protest shall provide citations or proofs where available to allow staff to properly consider the protest. The Water Division must receive a response or protest via email (<u>or</u> postal mail) within 20 days of the date the AL is filed.

The informing document should include an estimate of the date the proposed protest might be voted on.

REPLIES

The utility shall reply to each protest and may reply to any response. Any reply must be received by DWA within five business days after the end of the protest period, and shall be served on the same day to the person who filed the protest or response to the AL.⁶
