(a) The names, titles and duties of all Executive Officers and the compensation received by each such Executive Officer: "Executive Officer" includes the President, Secretary, Treasurer and Vice President in charge of a principal business unit, division or function of the respondent. It also includes any other person who performs policy making functions and is employed by the respondent:

Chief Executive Officer:

Delegates projects, responsibilities and authority, as necessary, to the President. The CEO also ensures that management and employees maintain a high water quality and employee safety along with providing the highest level of service possible. The CEO maintains industry affiliations and has the background knowledge necessary for the performance of his role.

Compensation Received: \$130,631

President & General Manager:

Under the direction of the CEO and Board of Directors, the P & GM is responsible for managing, planning, coordinating and administering all activities of the water company. These activities include, but are not limited *to*, the design, construction, operations and maintenance of the water company plant; coordinating with other managers in the company on all company matters; overseeing all employees by department; setting monthly company goals; and making policy decisions on a day-to-day basis. Also responsible for planning and executing the company's operating budget and responsible for the short and long-range strategy of the company, subject to review by the CEO and the Board of Directors.

Compensation Received: \$187,770

Field Operations Manager:

Manages field operations and field employees. He is directly responsible for capital planning and budget, plant maintenance, field scheduling and water distribution operations.

Compensation Received: \$109,661
