The package you receive via mail will include only those agenda items available at the time of the agenda distribution date, which is usually 10 to 12 days prior to the Commission meeting. ready on the distribution date, they will be made available at no charge in the lobby outside the Commission Auditorium at 9:00 a.m. on the morning of the Commission meeting, but not earlier.

Summary: On June 27, 2000, Bob Kargoll, Regulatory Director of AT&T Communications of California, Inc. (AT&T), met with Cmmr. Nepper, Cmmr. Duque, and Cmmr. Bilas in three separate meetings in San Francisco. At the meeting with Cmmr. Duque also present was Laura Krannawitter, advisor to Cmmr. Duque; at the meeting with Cmmr. Bilas - Lester Wong, advisor to Cmmr. Bilas. Rose Johnson and Rick Witherington, Government Affairs Vice Presidents of AT&T participated in all three meetings. Written materials (attached to the notice) were used. Kargoll explained why the Final Arbitrator's Report (FAR) erred in not establishing an equivalent reciprocal compensation payment structure between AT&T and Pacific Bell (PacBell).

Kargoll pointed out that, because AT&T's local switches cover a geographic area equivalent to PacBell's tandem switches, an equivalent compensation structure was justified. Johnson referred to the FAR's finding which limits when the alternate dispute resolution process can be used by AT&T and PacBell and stated that if the "one percent of carrier payments" cap adopted by the FAR left unchanged, many more disputes between AT&T and PacBell will need to be litigated before the Commission.
