Materials (attached to notice) consisting of a written handout, were used. Jacobsen stated that concerns about intraLATA toll service could be resolved through payments for wholesale services, affiliate transactions, and a limit on PBCOM facility-based authority and market share reporting. Jacobsen also stated that GTE's reliance on a separate long distance sales force will not be viable. Jacobsen further stated that Pacific Bell does not need to be handicapped with a separate sales force in order for markets to become competitive, and that other incumbent LECs who already offer long distance are not frustrating competition.
