This filing is for the purpose of revising certain of San Diego's gas rules pursuant to the Commission's Decision 93533, dated September 15, 1981, and Decision 93639, dated October 20, 1981, in Oli No. 49. The sheets being submitted pursuant to Decision 93533 revise San Diego's Rules 5, 6, 9, 10 and 11 in accordance with Ordering Paragraphs 1, 3, 4, 5, 6, including subparagraphs 6(1) through 6(5), 8, 9 and 11. A filing proposing similar revisions to San Diego's electric tariff schedules is being made concurrently by Advice Letter 554-E.

San Diego is aware that the changes ordered by Decision 93533 will necessitate the filing of an advice letter to implement the revision of certain of San Diego's existing Gas Department sample forms. However, San Diego has not included these sample forms at this time because they have not yet been revised. San Diego intends to continue utilizing the present forms until the revised forms become available.

In addition to the revisions to the rules being made as ordered by Decision 93533, San Diego is proposing to add a new Section A.4. to Rule 9, Rendering and Payment of Bills. This new section provides for the Company to bill a customer based on an estimate of his consumption when the Company is unable to read a customer's meter due to the inaccessibility of that meter. The wording in the new Section A.4. is almost identical to the wording which the Commission recently approved for PGandE by Resolution No. G-2440 dated September 1, 1981. The revision to PGandE's Rule 9 was filed by their Advice Letter 1166-G on July 31, 1981 and became effective September 1, 1981. A filing proposing the addition of similar wording to San Diego's electric Rule 9 is being made concurrently by Advice Letter 554-E.

This filing will not increase any rate or charge, conflict with other schedules or rules nor cuase the withdrawal of service. Therefore, in accorance with Ordering Paragraph 3 of Decision 93639, this filing will become effective as of the date of filing.

In accordance with Section III-G of General Order 96-A, San Diego has on January 20, 1982, served a copy of this filing to the parties shown below by mailing them a copy hereof, properly stamped and addressed.
