

The purpose of this filing is to revise each of San Diego's tariffo containing rates applicable for all non-exempt industrial boiler fuel customers in order to implement the alternative fuel price ceiling established by the Energy Information Administration (EIA), plus applicable taxes, that will be effective for San Diego's May 1982 billing period. This filing is being made in accordance with the procedure set forth in Section 9 of San Diego's Gas Department Preliminary Statement which was authorized by Commission Resolution G-2334 dated November 30, 1979 and reaffirmed by Resolution G-2334R on June 9, 1980.

This filing will not result in a revenue increase for the twelve months commencing May 1, 1982.
