

This supplemental filing is being made pursuant to Ordering Paragraphs 1 and 2 of Decision 82-12-058, dated December 13, 1982, in Application 39788. The purpose of this supplemental filing is to revise rate schedules and the supplemental rate sheet for Special Contract 176 to reflect an increase in rates to 1) offset 1983 financial and operational attrition and 2) offset the increased revenue requirement for San Diego determined in Decision 82-12-047 by this Commission.

Pursuant to Decision 82-12-058, the estimated annual increase in revenue over present rates related to 1) the increased revenue requirement determined in Decision 82-12-047 is \$9.4 million and 2) 1983 financial and operational attrition is \$10.8 million. Therefore, the total estimated annual increase in revenue over present rates reflected in the rates authorized by Decision 82-12-058 is \$20.2 million.

Attached is a table which shows the calculation of the authorized \$10,783,200 1983 attrition allowance for San Diego. The attached table replaces the table attached to Advice Lotter 504-G.

Implementation of San Diego's 1983 attrition allowance necessitates the revision of the "dase Cost Amount" set forth in Section 8.(b)(3) of San Diego's Gas Department Preliminary Statement. As of January 1, 1983, the "Base Cost Amount" for San Diego will be \$103,427,500. The development of this amount is as follows:

As a means of expediting this matter and to aid in tariff administration, San Diego requests withdrawal of the tariff and supplementary rate sheets submitted with Advice Letter 504-G, but not the advice letter itself.

San Diego requests that the variff and supplemental rate sheets submitted by this supplemental filing be made effective for service rendered on or after January 1, 1983. The proposed January 1, 1983 effective date is the effective date intended by Decision 93892 as stated on Page 30 of Decision 82-12-058.
