



IDSM RESULTS

- 1,353,850 kWh savings, 167 kW demand
 - \$126,118 in EE incentives
 - High efficiency chillers & boilers
 - VFDs
 - Efficient lighting system with controls
 - Auto-DR
- First hotel in California to incorporate Auto-DR into building design

- Roof-mounted solar panels, used to heat the hotel pool
 - Electric vehicle charging stations
 - LEED Gold






IDSM as **CPUC** Policy

The California Long Term Energy
 Efficiency Strategic Plan (CLTEESP)
 highlighted DSM program integration as a strategic planning priority.

Vision: Energy efficiency, energy conservation, demand response, advanced metering, and distributed generation technologies are offered as elements of an integrated solution that supports energy and carbon reduction goals immediately, and eventually water and other resource conservation goals in the future.




At SCE: DR IDSM

 For the 2009-2011 EE and DR proceedings, the Joint ACR dated April 11, 2008, provided the following guidance:

"IDSM programs involving the use of demand response funds should be clearly indicated in both energy efficiency and demand response applications."

 SCE submitted EE SW IDSM and DR IDSM programs in the 2009 -2011, 2012, 2013-2014 and 2015 DR and EE funding applications





2012-2014 IDSM Guidance in DR OIR




- For the 2012-2014 DR program application, the utilities were directed to include funding to <u>continue existing integrated activities</u> (<u>DR IDSM</u>) for one year (2012).
- Future authority and funding for <u>IDSM activities to be considered in future energy efficiency proceedings</u>, starting with the energy efficiency applications for 2013-2015.
- Activities in these categories that are <u>specific to demand response</u> and are not conducted jointly with energy efficiency programs <u>are</u> <u>not properly considered to be IDSM.</u>
