SUBJECT: Permission to Occupy Both Sides of a Thoroughfare with Class "H" Lines.

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY having requested permission by letter of June 22, 1950, to occupy both sides of Athlone Road between U.S. Highway No. 99 and Bliss Road, Merced County, with Class "H" Lines, and

WHEREAS: In the absence of such permission such occupancy would constitute a violation of Rule 31.3 of General Order No. 95, and

WHEREAS: Said occupancy is not presently detrimental to the requirements of other utilities in the same area,

IT IS FOUND that the requested permission should be granted and good cause appearing

IT IS ORDERED that permission be and is hereby granted Pacific Gas and Electric Company to occupy both sides of Athlone Road between U.S. Highway No. 99 and Bliss Road (a distance of approximately 15,119 feet), Merced County with Class "H" Lines substantially in accordance with the sketch plan attached to its letter of June 22, 1950; provided that if future circumstances require the use of any space so appropriated for other utility facilities, Pacific Gas and Electric Company will promptly cooperate in effecting such reconstruction as may be necessary equitably to resolve conflicting requirements.

The Secretary is directed to cause appropriate notice to be given said utility of the granting of this authorization.
