SUBJECT: Permission to Deviate from Provisions of Rules 38, 54.9-B2, and 54.9-E of General Order No. 95.

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY having requested permission, by letter of June 26, 1950, to deviate in certain particulars from the provisions of Rules 38, 54.9-B2, and 54.9-E of General Order No. 95 with respect to steel-pole rack construction in a limited portion of the business district in the City of Richmond, and

WHEREAS: It appears that the proposed construction will create no undue hazards or lessening of normal safety if maintenance work thereon is performed from tower or ladder trucks, but will permit certain economies of construction,

IT IS FOUND that permission to deviate should be granted, and good cause appearing

IT IS ORDERED that Pacific Gas and Electric Company be and is hereby granted permission to deviate from the provisions of Rules 38, 54.9-B2, and 54.9-E to the extent, as set forth in its letter of request dated June 26, 1950, which is necessary to permit construction, operation and maintenance of the steel poles and the conductors and facilities supporting them or supported thereby shown on Exhibit A attached to said letter provided maintenance or other work to be performed on said conductors or facilities is performed from ladder trucks.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the permission to deviate, above granted, shall apply only to those steel poles, conductors and facilities situated in the limited portion of the City of Richmond shown in detail on Exhibit B attached to the letter above mentioned.

The Secretary is directed to cause appropriate notice to be given said utility of the granting of this authorization.
