SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Changes in Tariff Schedules Which May Result in Increases in Rates or Charges.

WHEREAS: COAST COUNTIES GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY by Advice No. 96-E, filed June 28, 1950, having requested authority to make revisions in its tariff schedules effective on 30 days' notice as designated on Revised Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 430-E to 433-E, inclusive, relating to rates for street lighting service, which revisions will result in some minor decreases and no increases in charges to present customers, but may result in higher charges for future service than those presently offered, and


IT APPEARING that such increased rates or charges as may result from the above revisions are justified; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 63(a) of the Public Utilities Act to make the above revisions effective July 28, 1950, which is on statutory notice.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the tariff sheets issued in accordance with the order herein contained shall be marked to show that such sheets were issued under Resolution No. E-711 of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California.
