WHEREAS: PACIFIC CAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY has submitted for filing three special contracts dated January 17, 1950 for the rendering of street lighting service to Project City Street Lighting Association, Central Valley Street Lighting Association, and Leo Cullis, respectively, at rates that are lower than the utility's filed tariffs, authorisation by the Commission under Section 17(b) of the Public Utilities Act being required; and

WHEREAS: Said contracts were entered into prior to the issuance by the Commission on March 21, 1950 of Decision No. 43972 in Application No. 30717, in which applicant was directed to effect a general increase of six per cent in its electric tariffs including rates for service on certain special contracts; and

IT APPEARING that authorization of the aforesaid special contracts and delivery of the service at the rates provided therein increased by six per cent is justified and good cause appearing; therefore

IT IS ORDERED that Pacific Gas and Slectric Company be and it hereby is authorized under Section 17(b) of the Public Utilities Act to carry out the terms and conditions of the said contracts and to charge and collect for the service rendered and to be rendered at the rates set forth therein increased by six per cent.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the contracts hereinbefore authorized shall be marked to show that each was authorized under Resolution No. E-712 of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California, and Pacific Gas and Electric Company shall, promptly thereafter notify the Commission of the date of first service and the date of termination of each of said contracts.

The Secretary is directed to cause a certified copy of this resolution to be mailed to the Pacific Cas and Electric Company.
