WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY, by Advice No. 87-E, filed on June 27, 1950, having requested authority to make revisions in its tariff schedules effective on 30 days' notice as designated in its Preliminary Statement set forth on Revised Cal. P.U.C. Sheet No. 1909-E relating to the boundaries of Salinas Suburban, North, Special Rate Area No. 55, and having requested authority to establish Rate Schedule L-36, Sodium Vapor Street and Highway Lighting, effective upon 30 days' notice as set forth on Cal.
