SUBJECT: Permission to Occupy Both Sides of a Thoroughfare with Class "H" Lines.

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY having requested, by letter of July 25, 1950, to occupy both sides of Elm Road between a point approximately 604 feet south of the south line of Johnson Road to a second point approximately 3,395 feet south of the first point, all in Madera County, with Class "H" Lines and

WHEREAS: In the absence of such permission such occupancy would constitute a violation of Rule 31.3 of General Order No. 95, and

WHEREAS: Other than said occupancy would not at this time be economically justifiable and said occupancy is not presently detrimental to the requirements of other utilities in the same area,

IT IS FOUND that the requested permission should be granted, and good cause appearing

IT IS ORDERED that permission be and is hereby granted Pacific Gas and Electric Company to occupy both sides of Elm Avenue for a distance of approximately 3,395 feet, all in Madera County, with Class "H" Lines substantially in accordance with the sketch attached to its letter of request dated July 25, 1950; provided that if future circumstances require the use of any space so appropriated for other utility facilities, Pacific Gas and Electric Company will promptly cooperate in effecting such reconstruction as may be necessary equitably to resolve conflicting requirements.

The Secretary is hereby directed to cause appropriate notice to be given said utility of the granting of this authorization.
