SUBJECT: Permission to Occupy Both Sides of a Thoroughfare With Class "H" Lines.

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA EDISON COMPANY having requested permission, by letter of August 16, 1950, to construct an 11.5 kv supply circuit on the east side of Rockford Road (26N) for a distance of approximately 2758 feet to fill in open portions of an existing 11.5 kv line between Henderson Road (21E) and Road 23E, a distance of two miles, located in Tulare County, the opposite side of such road already being occupied by a 70 kv circuit of another utility, and

WHEREAS: In the absence of such permission such construction would constitute a violation of Rule 31.3 of General Order No. 95, and

WHEREAS: Other than said construction would not at this time be economically justifiable and said construction is not presently detrimental to the requirements of other utilities in the same area,

IT IS FOUND that the requested permission should be granted and, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that permission be and is hereby granted Southern California Edison Company to occupy the east side of Rockford Road (26N) in the vicinity of Porterville, Tulare County, for a distance of approximately 2758 feet, substantially in accordance with the sketch attached to its letter of request dated August 16, 1950; provided, that if future circumstances require the use of any space so appropriated for other utility facilities, Southern California Edison Company will promptly cooperate in effecting such reconstruction as may be necessary equitably to resolve conflicting requirements.

The Secretary is directed to cause appropriate notice to be given said utility of the granting of such permission.
