SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Revisions in Tariff Schedules on Less Than Statutory Notice which May Result in an Increase in Rates or Charges.

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY, by Advice No. 91-E, filed August 23, 1950, having requested authority under Section 15 of the Public Utilities Act to make effective on less than thirty days' notice, namely on September 1, 1950, revisions of its Preliminary Statement and Table of Contents, as designated on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 1938-E to 1940-E inclusive, relating to the description of special rate areas, which revisions may result in increased rates or charges to future customers; and

It appearing that such increased rates or charges as may result from the above revision in the Preliminary Statement are justified; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that authority be granted under Sections 15 and 63(a) of the Public Utilities Act to make the above described sheets effective on September 1, 1950.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the above described tariff sheets shall be marked to show that they were issued under Resolution No. E-723 of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California.
