SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Changes in Tariff Schedules which
May Result in an Increase in Rates or Charges.

WHEREAS: INDIAN VALLEY LIGHT AND POWER COMPANY by Advice No. 21, filed August 16, 1950, having requested authority to make revisions in its tariff schedules effective on 30 days' notice as designated in Rule and Regulation No. 22, Temporary Service, set forth on Revised Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 119-E to 121-E, inclusive, relating to the conditions for establishment of service of a temporary nature, and to operations of a speculative character or of questionable permanency, which said revisions may result in an increase in rates or charges requiring authorization by the Commission; and

IT APPEARING that such increased rates or charges as may result from the above revisions in the schedules of rates, rules and regulations are justified; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 63(a) of the Public Utilities Act to make the above sheets effective on September 15, 1950.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the tariff sheets issued in accordance with the order herein contained shall be marked to show that such sheets were issued under Resolution No. E-724 of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California.
