RETURN TO ELECTRIC DIVISION

SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Cancellation of Tariff Schedule Which May Result in an Increase in Rates or Charges.

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA EDISON COMPANY, by Advice No. 227, filed September 1, 1950, having requested authority to cancel on thirty days' notice its certain tariff schedule as designated in Schedule No. PFT-1, set forth on Revised C.R.C. Sheets Nos. 2312-E and 2313-E, effecting the withdrawal of Power - Flat Rate - Temporary Service, which cancellation of said tariff sheets may result in an increase in rates or charges requiring authorization by the Commission; and

It appearing that such cancellation of said tariff sheets is justified and good cause appearing; therefore

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 63(a) of the Public Utilities Act, to cancel the said tariff sheets effective October 1, 1950.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the tariff sheets cancelled in accordance with the order herein contained shall be marked to show that such sheets were cancelled under Resolution E-725 of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California.
