SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Changes in Tariff Schedules which

WHEREAS: CALIFORNIA-PACIFIC UTILITIES COMPANY, by Advice No. 30-E,
filed September 2, 1950, having requested authority to make revisions
in its tariff schedules effective on 30 days' notice as designated in
Schedule No. C-2-L set forth on Revised Cal. P.U.C. Sheet No. 213-E, relating
to general light and power service, which said revisions may result in an
