SUBJECT: Approval of Common Neutral Conductor Tag in Accordance with Rule 59.3-F, General Order No. 95.

WHEREAS: THE CALIFORNIA OREGON POWER COMPANY having requested approval by letter of October 2, 1950, of an aluminum tag to be used to designate the common neutral conductor on the proposed common neutral system in Montague, Siskiyou County, and

WHEREAS: In the absence of such approval the use of such tag would constitute a violation of Rule 59.3-F of General Order No. 95, and it appearing that tags as proposed would meet the requirements and intent of said rule, and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that approval be and hereby is granted The California Oregon Power Company to use aluminum tags as shown by its drawing attached to its letter of request dated October 2, 1950, for designating the common neutral conductor on the proposed common neutral system in Montague, Siskiyou County.

The Secretary is directed to cause appropriate notice to be given said utility of the granting of such approval.
