
SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Special Agreement Under Section X, Paragraph A. of General Order No. 96.

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA EDISON COMPANY having submitted for filing, and having requested authorization for, an agreement with the Pacific Electric Railway Company dated October 25, 1950, which agreement provides for electric service to the Railway Company during the two-year period from September 1, 1950 to August 31, 1952, under rates and/or conditions which differ from the filed tariffs of Southern California Edison Company, and the Commission being of the opinion that such authorization should be granted, therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that Southern California Edison Company be authorized under Section 17(b) of the Public Utilities Act to carry out the provisions of said agreement in accordance with the terms thereof.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the agreement hereinbefore authorized be marked to show that it was authorized under Resolution No. E-733 of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California.

The Secretary is directed to cause appropriate notice to be given to Southern California Edison Company of the granting of this authorization.
