SUBJECT: Permission to Support Temporary Decorative Equipment on Electric Trolley Facilities.

WHEREAS: THE TABERY CORPORATION of 3443 South Hill Street, Los Angeles, having by letter of November 6, 1950 requested permission to install and maintain decorative garlands, lighting and other decorative fixtures on the electric trolley facilities along Main Street, Santa Ana during the holiday season starting November 25, 1950, and

WHEREAS: It is found that the requested permission should be granted, and good cause appearing

IT IS ORDERED that The Tabery Corporation of Los Angeles is authorized to install and maintain temporary decorative garlands, lighting and other decorative fixtures on electric trolley facilities along Main Street, Santa Ana substantially in accordance with the plans shown on the drawing attached to its letter of request dated November 6, 1950. This authorization shall terminate on January 10, 1951 and shall not be construed as permitting any use of utility facilities for such temporary construction without the consent of all parties having ownership in the poles or facilities to which attachment may be made.

The Secretary is directed to cause appropriate notice to be given The Tabery Corporation of the granting of this authorization.
