SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Special Contracts Filed
Under Section X, Paragraph A of General Order No. 96.

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY has submitted for filing
copies of letter form agreements as follows:

Letter dated December 20, 1950 to Standard Oil Company
signed by James F. Pollard and accepted for Standard
Oil Company by O. N. Miller,

Letter Dated December 21, 1950 to Feather River Pine
Mills, Inc. signed by James F. Pollard and accepted
for Reather River Pine Mills, Inc. by Carl Walker, and

Letter dated December 29, 1950 to Ralph L. Smith
Lumber Company signed by James F. Pollard and accepted
for Ralph L. Smith Lumber Company by A. B. Hood,

which agreements cover the rendition of temporary surplus electric energy
at rates and special conditions that differ from the utility's filed
tariffs, and authorization by the Commission being required, and good
cause appearing, therefore

IT IS ORDERED that the Pacific Gas and Electric Company be authorized
under Section 17(b) of the Public Utilities Act to render the utility
service and charge the rates under the conditions and in accordance with
the terms of said letter agreements, and shall notify the Public Utilities
Commission of the date of termination of each of said agreements.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the letter agreements hereinbefore author-
ized shall be marked to show that they were authorized under Resolution
No. E-742 of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California.
