SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Changes in Tariff Schedules which May Result in an Increase in Rates or Charges.

WHEREAS: VALLEJO ELECTRIC LIGHT AND POWER COMPANY, by Advice No. 37 filed January 29, 1951, having requested authority to make revisions in its tariff schedules effective on more than 30 days' notice as designated in Rule and Regulation No. 16, Service Connections and Facilities on Customer's Premises, set forth on Revised Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 232-E to 238-E, inclusive, relating to provisions for the establishment of electric service connections to and facilities for rendering service on customer's premises which said revisions will result in no increase in rates or charges to present customers but may result in higher rates or charges for the establishment of service in the future than those presently provided, and

It appearing that such increased rates or charges as may result from the above revisions in the schedules of rates, rules and regulations are justified; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 63(a) of the Public Utilities Act to make the above sheets effective on March 1, 1951.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the tariff sheets issued in accordance with the order herein contained shall be marked to show that such sheets were issued under Resolution No. E-744 of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California.
