								Split Fiber Conduit Installed Protective Covering for

Risers from Underground Electric Cables.

WHEREAS: CALIFORNIA ELECTRIC POWER COMPANY having requested permission by letter of January 30, 1951 to use longitudinally split fiber conduit installed over metal conduit as a suitable protective covering for risers

WHEREAS: In the absence of such permission such use would constitute a violation of Rule 22.2 of General Order No. 95, and

from underground electric cables, and

WHEREAS: The company desires to use such split fiber conduit only on installations where it is necessary to extend the protective covering downward over a riser at some date subsequent to the initial installation of said riser, and the use of fiber conduit which is not split would require an interruption to service in addition to a higher installation cost, and

WHEREAS: It appears that safety to workmen will not be lessened by the use of such material when installed and maintained in the manner proposed by the company,

IT IS FOUND that the requested permission should be granted, and good cause appearing

IT IS ORDERED that permission be and is hereby granted California Electric Power Company to use longitudinally split fiber conduit installed over metal conduit to extend the protective covering downward over a riser at some date subsequent to the initial installation of said riser, provided that the material and installation thereof is in every case substantially in accordance with the sketch attached to its letter of request dated January 30, 1951.

The Secretary is hereby directed to cause appropriate notice to be given said utility of the granting of this authorization.
