WHEREAS: CALIFORNIA ELECTRIC POWER COMPANY, having requested by letter of February 16, 1951, permission to occupy both sides of Gilbert Street between Mayberry Avenue and Florida Avenue for a distance of approximately 2400 feet, all in the vicinity of Hemet, Riverside County, with Class "H" lines, and

WHEREAS: In the absence of such permission such occupancy would constitute a violation of Rule 31.3 of General Order No. 95, and

with Class "H" Lines.

WHEREAS: Other than said occupancy would not at this time be economically justifiable and said occupancy is not presently detrimental to the requirements of other utilities in the same area,

IT IS FOUND that the requested permission should be granted, and good cause appearing

IT IS ORDERED that permission be and is hereby granted California Electric Power Company to occupy both sides of Gilbert Street between Mayberry Avenue and Florida Avenue in the vicinity of Hemet, Riverside County, substantially in accordance with the print of its drawing D20-452a attached to its letter of request dated February 16, 1951; provided that if future circumstances require the use of any space so appropriated for other utility facilities, California Electric Power Company will promptly cooperate in effecting such reconstruction as may be necessary equitably to resolve conflicting requirements.

The Secretary is hereby directed to cause appropriate notice to be given said utility of the granting of this authorization.
