SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Changes in Tariff Schedules or Service
which Will Result in Increases in Rates or Charges.

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY by Advice No. 98-E, filed April 12, 1951, having requested authority to make revisions in its tariff Schedules effective on thirty days' notice, as designated in Schedules L-30, L-31, L-32, L-33, L-53 and L-54, as set forth on Revised Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 1989-E to 1994-E, relating to street lighting service, which said revisions will result in increases in certain rates or charges requiring authorization by the Commission; and

It appearing that such increased rates or charges as will result from the above revisions in the schedules of rates are justified; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 63(a) of the Public Utilities Act to make the above described sheets effective on May 12, 1951.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the tariff sheets issued in accordance with the order herein contained shall be marked to show that such sheets were issued under Resolution No. E-753 of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California.
